



Spring Landscape Must-Dos

Application of Pre-Emergent, Post-Emergent, and Fertilization

You can help prevent weeds from germinating by applying

PRE-EMERGENT WEED CONTROL

Apply pre-emergent three times a year in March, May, and September.

POST-EMERGENT WEED CONTROL

Apply post-emergent three times a year in March, May, and September.

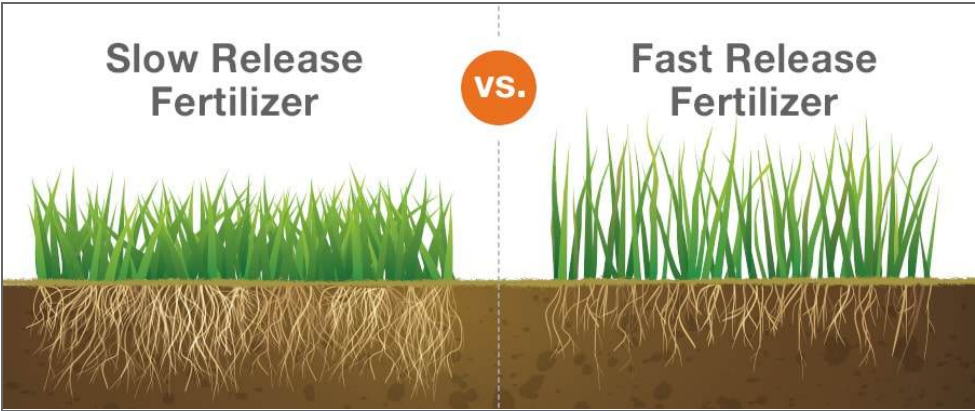
For a healthier and more vibrant lawn, use a

Apply fertilizer three times a year in March, May, and September.

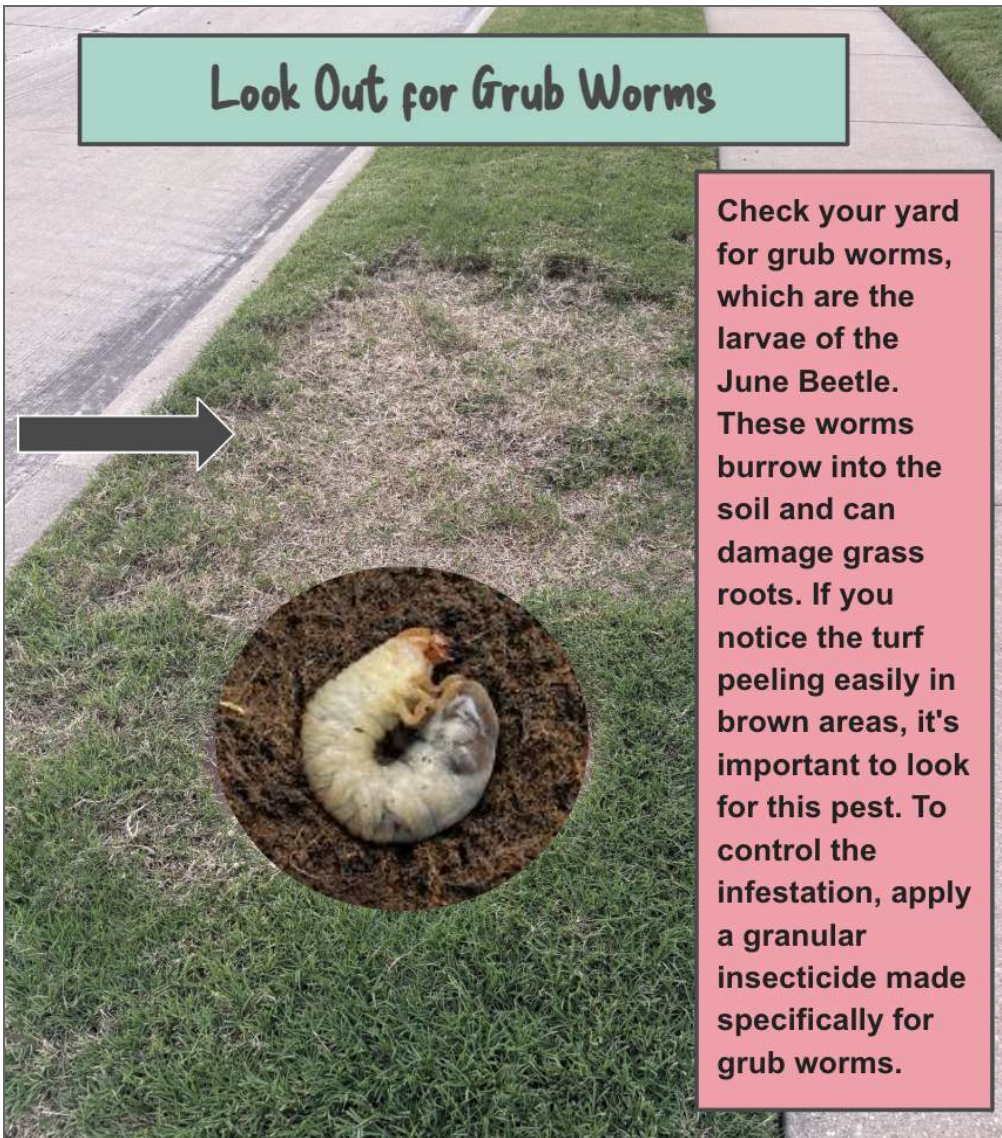
Scott's is a quality fertilizer choice. Be sure to read the label on the back of the bag to confirm that it is slow-release. Compared to fast-release fertilizers, slow-release types promote more uniform growth, are less likely to burn your

turf, last longer in the soil, and are less polluting — plants and turf absorb 90% of the fertilizer, with only 10% entering the environment.

Look Out for Grub Worms



Check your yard for grub worms, which are the larvae of the June Beetle. These worms burrow into the soil and can damage grass roots. If you notice the turf peeling easily in brown areas, it's important to look for this pest. To control the infestation, apply a granular insecticide made specifically for grub worms.

IRRIGATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Use these suggested run times to help set efficient watering schedules for your landscape during periods of drought.

Keep in mind that every landscape is different, so please adjust according to your area's needs and watering restrictions.

- Spray Heads: 12 - 20 minutes
- Rotor Heads: 30 - 45 minutes
- Bubbler Heads: 5 - 10 minutes
- Drip: 30 - 45 minutes

From October through May, your system will normally remain OFF. Stay tuned here for how often to run your controller during the rest of the year!
