



## **JUNE LANDSCAPE TIPS FOR HEAT PREPARATION & PLANT PROTECTION:**

- Monitor your irrigation closely and be aware of city watering restrictions.
- For new plantings, hand-water when needed.
- Mulch if you haven't yet or if you need to replenish: Mulch conserves moisture, suppresses weeds, moderates soil temperature, and slowly breaks down to improve soil structure.
- Check frequently for insects and diseases and treat as needed.\*\*
- Mow weekly.
- Fertilize trees.\*\*
- Do not let up on weeds.\*\*



*\*\*When treating insects and diseases, controlling weeds, and fertilizing, always follow label instructions for application and watering to ensure safe and effective plant care.*

## **IMPORTANT REMINDER:** **If you have new trees– Check the Staking Materials**



If it has been more than a year since your tree was planted, gently shake the trunk. If the root ball does not move, remove all staking materials. DO NOT let the guy wires cut into the bark and damage the tree! If the root ball still moves, leave the staking materials in place, but loosen all ties as needed to prevent damage to branches and the trunk.

### IRRIGATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Use these suggested run times to help set efficient watering schedules for your landscape during periods of drought.

Keep in mind that every landscape is different, so please adjust according to your area's needs and watering restrictions.

- Spray Heads: 12 - 20 minutes
- Rotor Heads: 30 - 45 minutes
- Bubbler Heads: 5 - 10 minutes
- Drip: 30 - 45 minutes

From October through May, your system will normally remain OFF. Stay tuned here for how often to run your controller during the rest of the year!
